Snippets from the Village History:

The Village Hall written by Katie Goudy

By the end of 1940 there was a balance of £2.0s.10d. In the electric lighting account, this was considered very satisfactory, it was clearly seen that the charge of 6d. Per hour covered the cost - pity it doesn't now!

By this time the Army, which were stationed at the Manor and surrounding area were using the Hall for most evenings except Wednesdays when the Home Guard used it.

Many chairs had got broken during the past 2 years and were beyond repair, so it was decided to purchase 50, the price being 14/- each, and Mr W Ling (bus proprietor) kindly offered to collect these and deliver to the Hall.

In 1946 the chairs, floor, roof and platform were discussed.

In 1947 it was pointed out that the roof was leaking badly in several places, the porch over the front door needed attention and also the brickwork of the kitchen chimney and floor, and the whole building needed to be creosoted and painted outside.

The Scouts, Guides, Cubs and Brownies were now using the Hall every week

In 1949 heating the Hall be electricity was discussed, but it was considered too expensive to prove satisfactory, and the terrible condition of the Ladies toilet was brought to notice, but it was 1951 before it was eventually remedied, as it was still the old fashioned pail and it was decided hat the pail be removed from the back instead of coming through the cloakroom each time it was emptied. This was thought a good idea.





Wetheringsett cum Brockford Parish Council Report on the video meeting held Monday 7th September 2020

<u>Planning Applications</u> – a number of applications and/or appeal notices had been received from MSDC relating to change of use of the land in Mendlesham/ Brockford Road for residential static and touring caravans. Members considered the applications carefully and a recommendation of refusal was agreed on the following grounds:

- MSDC already has a 5 year land supply
- There are already 23 approved static/touring caravan pitches in Mendlesham/Brockford Road
- The proposed sites are within a level 3 flood plain
- The proposed sites are outside the settlement boundary and would involve destruction of historic water meadows adjacent the River Dove
- Concerns have been raised over the number of inappropriate accesses created onto Mendlesham/Brockford Road outside the 30mph speed limit and concerns over waste and sewage disposal in a flood plain were raised as well as the sites being in open countryside with no safe pedestrian access to services

<u>Village Hall</u> – the village hall committee continue to make improvements to the hall. As leaseholders, the Parish Council has made contributions to the cost of the following improvement work: refurbishment of the wooden floor, repairs to water faults in the cloakrooms, redecorating the interior, repairs to window frames and new blinds and improved lighting. The committee is also looking to make improvements to the kitchen including some new appliances. The work has made a huge difference to the ambience of the interior of the hall which will should improve its booking potential when the hall fully re-opens. The committee are looking into setting up an online booking system. Members recorded thanks to the committee for their time and work in organising the improvements.

<u>Town Lane containers.</u> Following concerns raised over the height of stacked containers, District Cllr Andrew Stringer is obtaining advice from Planning Officers at MSDC. There are permitted heights and if there is a breach Mid Suffolk will be looking to bring enforcement action.


