# Village Hall News



By the time you read this, some of you will hopefully have visited the Hall and seen the work that has been done.

The project followed on from a meeting in the Village Hall some two years ago when the question was asked, do we refurbish the Hall or build a new one? This sounds straightforward, but history has an impact on the answer. The Village Hall is a registered charity, its origins go back to 1921. The Parish Council own the lease on the Hall, and the Village Hall Committee are responsible for finding the money to maintain it. Over the years the Parish Council has been pleased to support the primary school, firstly with the education department and now with the MAT (Multi Academy Trust responsible for the school) with regards to school use of the hall during term time. The hall has also fostered good relationships with the Church for Harvest Suppers and with the Middy, taking part in its activities. It has remained a solid asset for the benefit of the whole Parish, as every Village Hall should be.

The closure of the Hall through the COVID pandemic provided us with the opportunity to update the hall and a huge thank you is owed to the small team of individuals who have worked to make refurbishment a reality. There was a "windfall" moment, when a tree fell on the roof (thankfully no one was hurt), and the insurance claim paid for a new roof and the removal of hazardous asbestos;

an individual made an incredibly generous donation, which allowed the south wall to be rebuilt, Councillor Andrew Stringer advised about local grant applications from Suffolk County Council, which facilitated redecoration and replacement windows and the Townsland Trust made a loan for the floor replacement. In addition, local people wielded paint brushes, and sanders, rebuilt the stage and cleared debris from past years. The Village Hall Committee bought 60 new chairs. This was truly a “patchwork “of help.



There will always be other things we could have done, but we hope you will agree that the Village Hall now looks fit for purpose and will provide a space for village activities in years to come.

**Special thanks must go to Mike Pease, for overseeing the project and to the members of the Village Hall Committee, past and present, who have risen to the challenge of keeping it running.**

Going forward, funds are low and we need to raise money to ensure the Hall’s future. Our running costs are due to rise with the projected increase in electricity, and our main income is from rentals and community fund raising events. So, if you have a family event, please think of our Hall as a venue. If you have an idea for an event or a club this space could suit your needs.

The Village Hall accounts will be made available to the next Parish Council Meeting and we welcome interest from any parishioner who would like to get involved in the future.



**Wetheringsett cum Brockford Parish Council**  
**Report on the meeting held Monday 7th March 2022**

**Village Hall** – Cllr Pease was pleased to report the refurbishment work was now complete and as reported in the last magazine, huge thanks were recorded to Cllr Pease for leading the project. Photographs showing progress of the work can be seen on the Wetheringsett Parish Council website. It is hoped the renovation work will now attract much wider use of the hall from the community and outside the parish.

**Platinum Celebrations – Friday 3 June 2022, 2pm – 5pm** - Cllr Mrs Leech gave a report on progress for the Celebration, a grand Tea Party at the Village Hall and on the field and will also include a Flower Festival at the Church on the same day between 10am – 2pm. All parishioners welcome.

**Neighbourhood Plan** – a report on progress was received. The Working Group are working on the first full draft Plan. When complete the draft will be sent to Mid Suffolk District Council for their informal comments. Pending comments from Mid Suffolk the next consultation with parishioners should be held end of April/early May. A draft of the Plan should be available for Parish Council comments during April. Thanks were recorded to the Working Group for their work on the Plan to date – this will be an important document reflecting parishioners views for the future of the village.

**Storm Eunice** – the village sign was blown over as a result of the storm on 18 February resulting in a crack in the artwork. The sign is in the process of being restored.

**Play Area** – Cllr Barry Lacey is progressing improvement works in the play area – removal of the sleepers and replacement with a grassed slope and replacement of the bark chippings under the climbing frame. These will hopefully all be complete over the next few weeks.

**Grass cutting** – members were pleased to hear the grass contractor has agreed to carry on cutting the cemetery and play area again this year. As last year, there will be a No Mow May in the cemetery to enable the wild flowers to bloom. There will be at least four grass cuts and a strim over the grass cutting season.

**Date of next meeting: Monday 4 April 2022, 7pm at the Village Hall.**

### The Middy wins Award

On 26th February 2022 the Heritage Railway Association's Morgan Preservation Award was presented to the Mid-Suffolk Light Railway. The award is for the complete restoration of the Fowler diesel mechanical locomotive built for the Shredded Wheat Company in 1934.



The locomotive was used at the Welwyn Garden City Shredded Wheat Factory which was closed in 2007.

It was rescued from dereliction by Mr. Tony Goff and restored to operational health by Neal and Nigel Davis who are volunteers and members of the Middy.

The award was presented by Mr. Steve Oates, Chief Executive Officer of the Heritage Railway Association.

April 2022 Newsletter



This month I had planned to continue our series of 'What's On' for April.

However, the war in Ukraine has taken precedence in our hearts and thoughts, and if like me, you cannot turn away from the news reporting, it is difficult to contemplate things that we might want to celebrate.

The most significant events in the life of our churches will be the retelling of the Easter Story, from Palm Sunday, through Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. For the people of Ukraine, a 70% Christian country, celebrating the joy of Easter Sunday is going to be a challenging thing to do.

Just as we were called to keep hope alive during the long months of the pandemic, we are called to be bearers of hope again, and that is hard and challenging.....  
So, what can our churches and communities do to help the people of Ukraine?

We are a people of hope and there are things we can do:

- **Be Prayerful**





**I love live music and now that restrictions have lifted, I'm keen to start going to events again. I've booked tickets for some gigs over the next few months, but I'm still a little worried. I can't quite believe things are fully back to normal. What will happen**

### **if restrictions come back in?**

It's understandable to be feeling apprehensive when there's been so much change, and knowing your rights will help you deal with anything unexpected.

If you've got tickets to an event which goes ahead, but you change your mind about going or realise you're no longer able to go, you have no legal right to a refund. However, if the event is cancelled, your right to a refund will depend on how you bought the ticket.

If you booked through an official seller and the organiser cancels, moves, reschedules, or makes the event behind closed doors, you should get a refund. This is true even if it's cancelled due to a government ban on large events. If this happens, contact the official seller to find out how you can get a refund.

If you bought your ticket from a ticket-reselling website, your refund will depend on the site's terms and conditions. If you're worried about the event being cancelled, it's a good idea to look at the terms and conditions before booking.

If you bought from a private seller, unfortunately it's unlikely you'll be able to recover your money, even if the event is cancelled or rescheduled. We recommend contacting the seller to see what they can do.

Ahead of any events you've booked, keep checking the information from the official seller or organiser to make sure you know straight away about any updates, like changes to the date or cancellations.

Another thing to be aware of is that scammers exploit these situations for their own benefit. If your event is cancelled and anyone - whether it's a person or a company - offers their services to try to recover money on your behalf, be suspicious. Make sure that you're aware of the signs of a potential scam and always be on the lookout.
